A: BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE

Persistent challenges such as gender inequality, child vulnerability, mental health concerns, unemployment, limited economic opportunities, and widening digital divides continue to undermine social inclusion and resilience. These challenges are further intensified by global crises, including economic instability, public health emergencies, climate change, and social exclusion, highlighting the urgent need for innovative, inclusive, and evidence-based responses.

The First International Conference on **People's Empowerment and Wellbeing** is organized by the Institute of Social Work to respond to these interconnected issues by providing a platform for critical dialogue, knowledge exchange, and collaborative learning. The conference brings together scholars, researchers, practitioners, policymakers, development partners, and civil society actors to share research findings, experiences, and best practices across disciplines and sectors.

The rationale for the conference is grounded in the recognition that sustainable wellbeing requires integrated, people-centered approaches that link research, policy, and practice. By promoting interdisciplinary perspectives and cross-sectoral collaboration, the conference aims to generate policy-relevant insights, strengthen academic and professional networks, and contribute to transformative actions that advance people's empowerment and sustainable wellbeing at local, national, and global levels.
